Request received by Diocesan Office
<ol> <li>Lay Person completes Form for Visiting Lay Ministers (Appendix 18);</li> <li>Church Leader or Head of relevant Organisation to which the Lay Person belongs completes Confirmation of Good Standing Form for Lay Persons (Appendix 20);</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>If the ministry involves contact with children or vulnerable persons, which is more than incidental, then the Lay Person must be vetted by the Diocese of Limerick. This is organised via <u>vetting@ldo.ie</u> (queries to Vetting Service in the Diocesan Office)</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Bishop of Limerick communicates his decision to the Lay Person and relevant local Parish/Organisation (Appendix 14)</li> </ol>
